## Definitions for Harvest Festival pricing purposes:

- BIA Member – a licensed business operating in Downtown PoCo
- Business – any venture for profit including home based
- Crafter – any person who is offering to sell their own works
- Registered Non-Profit – registered and in good standing with the Province of BC

Any vendors intending to offer food products for sale or promotion must submit their menu with prices (or intention to offer at n/c) with application. They must also be entirely self-contained and be approved by the Fraser Health Authority. Your valid permit must be displayed on event day.
